Drive time from the villa: About 15 minutes.

Location: A few minutes south of Soufriere on the main highway.

Ziplining at Morne Coubaril Estate

An upbeat and fun activity than can be enjoyed by honeymooners, families and of course adventure explores! It combines the adrenaline rush of zipping under the sheer Petit Piton, with elevated views of the historic town of Soufriere and the Caribbean Sea.

They have 8 zip lines. This is a good choice if you are new to zip lining or don't mind a course that isn't the fastest, highest and biggest. It's also nearby – the most extreme course on the island is about 90 minutes away (each way).

Minimum age: 8 years Maximum Weight: 260 pounds Hours: The first zipline booking is available starting at 8:30 with the last starting at 3:30 Cost: \$75US for adults, \$37.50US for children (8 – 12). Prices exclude tax. They used to offer a buffet lunch – contact them for availability if you are interested. Booking is available on their website.

Treetop Adventure Park – highest and fastest zip lining

Drive time from the villa: About 90 minutes.

Location: Near Dennery, near the east side of the island. Although it's a little north-east of the villa, there are no roads through the interior until further north. You will either go south to Vieux Fort and up along the east side or drive up to north of Marigot Bay and then cut across the interior.

World-class zip lining

Trained guides take you on the ride of your life on a course designed for maximum thrills and exposure to the best views of the rainforest. Name 'Best Zip Line in the Caribbean' by ShoreTrips, our course has 12 lines, including the island's longest, highest and fastest, as well as five net bridges which allow plenty of time to take in the unique panoramic views and observe the magnificent flora and fauna indigenous to the forest.

We've done this zip line course. If you are looking for the fastest, longest and highest course on the island, this is it!

Location: Near Babonneau, northeast of Castries in the northern part of the island.

Adrena-Line Canopy Tour – Mama’s Boys Need not Apply!

The Adrenaline zip line tour is not for the faint of heart.. You get hitched up to a series of cables and zip from platform to platform high up in the tree canopy. If your adrenaline isn’t flowing then, a brisk hike to the next set of platforms will juice things up a bit before you zip safely and with a thrill to the base camp.

We suggest you plan ahead for this as it appears they are only open on certain days of the week, and the starting time is 9:45 AM. Their website allows on-site booking.

Cost: \$55-\$75 US per person; children 12 and under are \$32-\$65 US per person. Prices exclusive of parking fees and transportation.

Rainforest Adventure – Aerial tram

Drive time from the villa: About 90 minutes, although traffic can impact this.

Location: Near Babonneau, northeast of Castries in the northern part of the island. Same location as the zip lining.

Ride a gondola high through the rainforest

The Aerial Tram tour at Rainforest Adventures St. Lucia transports guests up and away from the heat and bustle of the lowlands to an ecological park located in the heights of St. Lucia’s forest reserve. Sixteen open-air gondolas ascend noiselessly through the rainforest, offering guests a magical view of nature in its majesty – towering gommiers, impressive chatanniers, and the remarkable phenomenon of the strangler ficus, alighted upon by playful hummingbirds and banana quits. An experienced Nature Interpreter will point out giant ferns and magnificent heliconia and identify the calls and the plumage of the birdlife that makes the Caribbean Oceanic forest their home. Tour includes: 1) Aerial tram ride 2) Fern Nature trail 3) One (1) Nature Interpreter per group of eight (8) guests

Tour Duration: 2.5 hours. **Cost:** \$55-\$75 US per person; children 12 and under are \$32-\$65 US per person. Prices exclusive of parking fees and transportation.

Saint Lucia Helicopters

Drive time from the villa: 60-70 minutes, although traffic can increase this.

Location: At the small airport in Castries (Georges F. L. Charles).

Few places anywhere offer the spectacular scenery that is St Lucia. And there is no better way to take it all in than by helicopter. Your pilot's informative and lively commentary rounds out the experience which you won't soon forget.

They offer a tour of the north and of the south, and one that includes both. We believe the tours take off from the small airport in Castries.

Prices are from \$115US to \$225US per person depending on the tour. Prices exclude tax. Children 12 and under appear to be a 10% discount from the adult ticket price. Weight limit per ticket: 265 pounds. Minimum four passengers; maximum six passengers.
